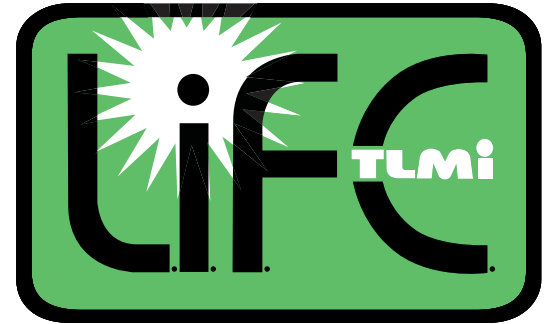

L.I.F.E. or Label Initiative for the Environment is an audited certification program tailored to help our members find effective ways to reduce their company's environmental footprint and demonstrate effective sustainable and environmental initiatives within their manufacturing processes. L.I.F.E. Certification addresses sustainable process issues such as reducing total energy consumption
