


Did you know that your label release liner is recyclable and has value?



TLMI, the trade association for the label industry, is committed to increasing paper and film release liner recycling. As an association of providers into the label industry, TLMI has taken many intentional steps to increase the viability of label release liner recycling and ensure acceptance as a feedstock into new products. When release liner is recycled, it helps to promote a circular economy by reusing a label byproduct as a feedstock to create new products.

Paper release liner can be used as a feedstock for tissue paper, paper board, corrugated cardboard, and more*.

Filmic release liner, through chemical recycling, can be processed back into raw materials that have multiple applications such as feedstock for automotive parts, injection molding, packaging, and more.

*The Recycled Materials Association, ReMA, (formerly ISRI) has designated paper release liner as paper specialty grade 37-S in the ReMA Scrap Specifications Circular.
